Beautiful travertine features naturally occurring holes and troughs throughout giving this treasured stone an aged, weathered texture and appearance. A variance in color and texture is to be expected and speaks to the one-of-a-kind nature of these pieces.

Care for Your Travertine

Preserve the unique characteristics of travertine with these care essentials:

- > Address spills immediately by wiping with a dry, soft cloth. Natural stone is a porous material, and although it has been sealed, spills should be blotted promptly to minimize staining.
- > Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth.
- > Do not use window cleaning fluids, scouring compounds, gritty cloths, or strong solvents such as alcohol, ammonia or acetone as they may damage the finish.
- > Use coasters, trivets and placemats for protection against hot or wet items.
