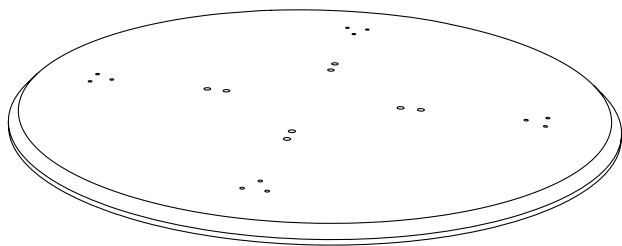

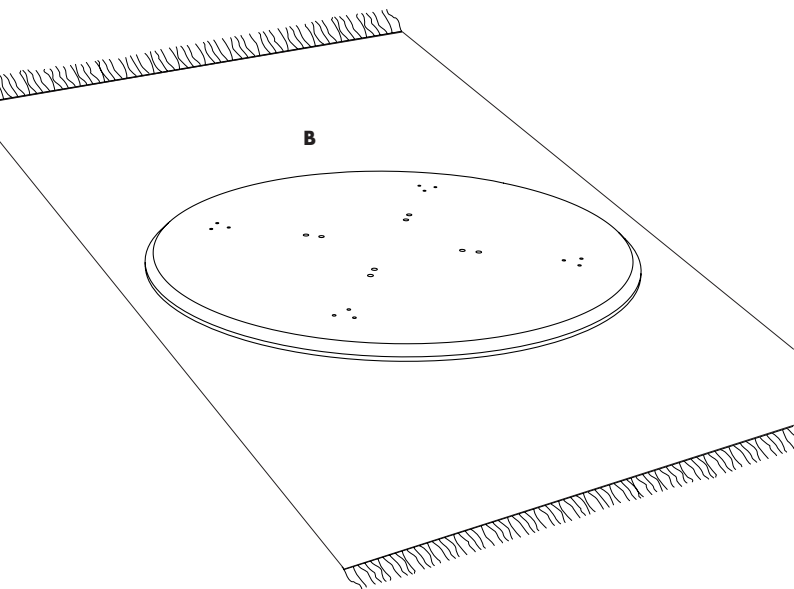

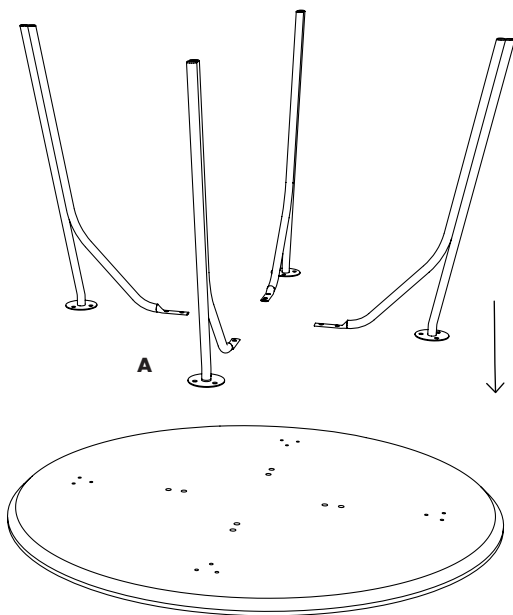
# STEP 1

PLACE THE TABLE TOP ON A SOFT CARPET OR RUG



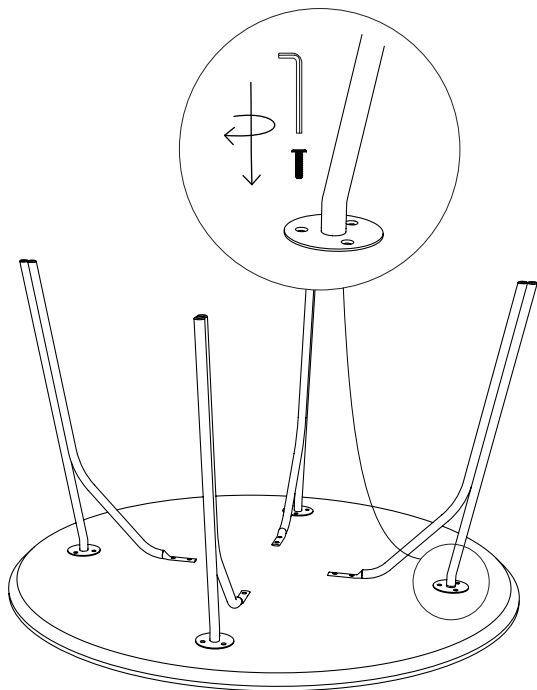
## STEP 2
